SECTIONAL ANALYSIS

Section 1: Deletes the requirement that the annual report from the Department of Commerce regarding courtesy military licenses be specifically delivered to the JASC.

Section 2: Separates the seat shared by the Alaska Federation of Natives and the Alaska Municipal League into two full seats, one for each entity.

Section 3: Total committee membership quorum requirement to conduct business is raised to nine members.

Section 4: Tasks the Legislative Affairs Agency with basic stewardship of the committee roster and to maintain both a list of previous recipients awarded the Alaska Decoration of Honor and a list of military members eligible to receive that award.

Section 5: Updates Scope and Purpose section.

Section 6: Eliminates overlap in legislative reporting requirements of the Alaska Military Commission.

Section 7: 10-year repealer.

Section 8: Re-appointment process copied from the Military Commission creation.

Section 9: Effective dates of repealer.
