Is Social Media Safe for Teens and Children?

95% of teens and 40% of kids 8-12 use social media significantly.



The Surgeon General in 2024 stated: “There is reason to be concerned about the risk of harm use of social media poses to children and adolescents.”

Why Would Online Platforms Allow Harm to Children?



Online platforms' business model is based on maximizing "screen time."

There is inadequate regulation of online providers to ensure young people's mental health is prioritized ahead of profit.
