#### Fire Warehouse Lease (Fairbanks)

Request for Proposal (RFP) development with Department of Transportation & Public Facilities Division of Facilities Services Leasing Office (ADOT&PF) began in June 2024 with the intent to award on Jan 27, 2025. This is a limited competition solicitation sent to four contractors that responded to a Request for Information from ADOT&PF on behalf of the Division of Forestry & Fire Protection on Feb 27, 2024, to determine level of interest prior to issuing the RFP.

#### Mat-Su Crew Facilities Lease (Palmer)

Request for Proposal (RFP) development with the Department of Transportation & Public Facilities Division of Facilities Services Leasing Office began in March 2024. An RFP for limited competition was issued to two proposers on April 9, 2024. One proposer responded and was declared non-responsive. ADOT subsequently canceled the RFP on June 3, 2024 in accordance with policy & procedures. ADOT&PF then sought and received authorization to engage in sole-source negotiations with the responder and proceeded in July 2024. The contractor is currently working on costs for a new facility in advance of negotiation meetings anticipated in January 2025.

#### **Agency Response**

The significant increase to the number of applicants on the Wildland Fire and Resource Technician (WFRT) classification is a direct reflection of the positive impacts related to the Mission Critical Incentive Pay letter of agreement. Applicant pools have increased from having to extend recruitments due to no applicant interest to now having anywhere from 30-80 applicants.
