Senate Bill 167 LS0491\G PFD Reimbursement for Wrongfully Convicted Individuals Explanation of Changes From A to N to I

Title: Adds language related to the eligibility of criminal offenders.

Version A To Version N

Section 1 (Section 2 of Version I)

Page 1, lines 12-13 of Version N: Added the language "and the dismissal was not part of a plea agreement in another criminal case under Rule 11, Alaska Rules of Criminal Procedure;"

This change makes it clear that individuals whose cases have been dismissed because they took a plea agreement would not qualify for this legislation.

Version N to Version I

Section 1: New section. Amends PFD eligibility statutes to disqualify somebody who has been convicted of murder in first or second degree, but is not incarcerated.

Sections 2-3: Previous sections 1-2, renumbered.

Section 4: New section. Conforms to public notice requirements regarding the value of a permanent fund dividend.

Section 5: New section. Conforms to restorative justice account language.

Section 6: New section. Applicability for section 1 of this bill.

Section 7: Previous section 3, renumbered.
