8 **"* Sec. 2.** AS 23.10.066 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

9 (b) A seasonal worker, unless otherwise permitted by the employer of the
10 seasonal worker, is not entitled to

11 (1) use paid sick leave for the first 30 days of employment;

12 (2) accrue or use more than 12 hours of paid sick leave each month; or

13 (3) retain paid sick leave past the last day of the seasonal employment.

14 (c) Employment of seasonal seafood processing workers is exempt from the
15 requirements of AS 23.10.066 - 23.10.068.

16 (d) In this section,

17 (1) "seasonal seafood processing worker" means an employee who is
18 hired to perform work involving heading, gutting, separating, filleting, or canning
19 seafood or other activities intended to prepare seafood for market for a specific period,
20 not to exceed six months each calendar year; and

21 (2) "seasonal worker" means an employee who is hired for a specific
22 period, not to exceed six months each calendar year, related to peak business need;
23 "seasonal worker" does not include a seafood processing worker."
