This bill elevates the charge level for the theft or destruction of mail by adding this conduct to the crime of theft in the 2nd degree, a Class C felony.		
The Agency is unable to accurately predict how many people would be charged under this statute and of those the number that would be appointed counsel. The Agency therefore submits an indeterminate fiscal note pending caseload increase estimates from the Department of Law.
