Analysis

This bill would require an annual report by the Department of Health to the legislature; however, the Department of Family and Community Services (DFCS) will be required to provide data to include children placed in psychiatric hospitals. This is data the department currently tracks and there would be no issue in providing said data.

However, DFCS may lack authority to collect data regarding minors not in its custody for purposes of reporting. The department does not anticipate any costs to the department to provide this data; therefore, a zero fiscal note is submitted.
