FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 30

Analysis

This legislation will waive business license fees for the first five years if a business has its principal place of business in Alaska. This will result in significantly reduced revenue for the general fund and increased paperwork to process related to the exemptions. The Business Licensing database would need system changes to collect additional information and appropriate fees. The Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing (CBPL) estimates over 17,000 business would qualify for a free new business license each year, resulting in \$883.7 in lost revenue per year for initial applications. It also estimates up to 92% of current license holders may be principally located in Alaska. This would result in an addition al \$1,136.6 in lost revenue to the general fund related to business license renewals.

If the bill passes, the following expenses will be incurred and paid from General Fund/Program Receipts, fund code 1005, as noted below:

Personal Servi	ces: \$101.7	One full-time Licensing Examiner 2 (range 15) located in Juneau.
Services:	\$88.3 \$25.0	One-time legal costs to amend regulations, printing, and postage in FY2026 only. Annual statewide and allocated core services costs for one position.
Commodities:	\$10.0 \$2.0	One-time set up costs for equipment and space for one position. Ongoing supply and equipment costs for one position.

Business licensing at CBPL is funded by General Fund/Program Receipts fund source 1005 GF/Prgm (DGF). Business licensing fees are set per AS 43.70, and revenue in excess of authorized budgeted expenses reverts to the State of Alaska general fund.
