FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 30

Analysis

This legislation amends a reporting requirement for the Office of Procurement and Property Management, removes the business license fee for certain new businesses, and creates the Office of Entrepreneurship (OOE) in the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED).

The OOE will be established as a new component in the Executive Administration and Development results delivery unit. The OOE is charged with promoting entrepreneurship in the state, as well as providing direct technical assistance to new businesses. Additionally, HB 30 adds a new section requiring state agencies to spend 5% of their appropriations for "economic development programs" for the benefit of new businesses in the state and to notify the OEE of those expenditures. Furthermore, the OOE is required to to provide an annual report to the legislature detailing legislation enacted in the previous year that supports, hinders, or otherwise affects new businesses in the state.

The OOE will be led by a Division Director. Two Program Coordinators will be tasked with providing direct technical assistance to new businesses and promoting entrepreneurship. The Program Coordinators will work closely with the Research Analyst to analyze the impacts of new legislation on businesses and will collaboratively compile and prepare the annual report to the legislature. One Accountant 3 will monitor, track, and report on the 5% economic development program expenditure requirement on state programs. The OOE will be supported by one Administrative Assistant 2.

The department does not currently have office space available for the OOE. New office space will need to be secured, estimated at 1,000 square feet at \$2.50 per square foot per month.
