FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB045

Analysis

This bill aims to align the Alaska Medicaid mental health and substance use disorder benefits with federal requirements. This bill requires the Department of Health (DOH), to comply with the requirements for mental health or substance use disorder benefit requirements, codified under 26 U.S.C. 9812, 29 U.S.C. 1185a, and 42 U.S.C.300gg-26 and to submit a report to the Legislature regarding a comparative parity analysis (an analysis about whether a health insurance plan provides equal coverage for mental health and substance use disorder services compared to medical/surgical benefits) and status on compliance.

The expected impact is improved access to behavioral health and substance use disorder services. The work will require dedicated resources, a staff member, and contracted services to ensure compliance and management duties of the analysis, the data collection processes and preparing the required report. Staff will need to evaluate existing Non-Qualitative Treatment Limitations (NQTLs) for material differences with medical/surgical (M/S) benefits, collect and analyze required data, and design or interpret data collection processes. Ongoing parity analysis and compliance will also involve regular reviews of NQTLs to address barriers to care and publishing public reports. For those reasons partnership with a contractor will be necessary. There will be costs associated with a designated full-time position for this work and for this contractor.

Regulations are anticipated to be adopted by December 31, 2027.

Financial Breakdown

One full-time Research Analyst 3 (including benefits): range 18, step C, in Juneau, will be needed at a cost of \$126.4.

Services: Office space, phone, reimbursable service agreements for position support: \$20.0 annually and service contract for parity analysis estimated to cost \$325.0.

Commodities: Starting in the second year office supplies \$2.0 annually.

One-Time Commodities Cost: Computer, software, and office equipment: \$5.0 in the first year.
