## Analysis

SB 24 would align Alaska's minimum age to purchase tobacco products, electronic smoking products, or products containing nicotine with Federal law (21 U.S.C. 387f(d) as amended by PL 116-94, December 20, 2019).		
The Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing (CBPL) does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.		
Business licensing at CBPL is funded by General Fund/Program Receipts fund source 1005 GF/Prgm (DGF). Business licensing fees are set per AS 43.70, and revenue in excess of authorized budgeted expenses reverts to the State of Alaska general fund.
