FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

The proposed legislation would change existing statutory language for Alaska Statute (AS) 11.46 by adding a new section related to organized theft when a person individually or jointly violates AS 11.46.120 or 11.46.130 in coordination with a group of three or more persons who have committed or attempted to commit two or more violations of AS 11.46.120 or 11.46.130 of, or at the direction of, or in association with the group, and makes organized theft a class A felony. The proposed legislation also adds medical records or other medical information as types of property, if the person commits theft as defined in AS 11.46.100 and is considered a theft in the second degree. Additionally, if there is mail theft, it is considered a crime of theft in the third degree. While it is expected that this legislation may have an impact on the daily offender population, there is no data available to project the actual impact. However, based on the current prison population, any increase can be absorbed within the department's existing resources and capacity. Therefore, a zero fiscal note is submitted for this legislation.
