Dear Representative Elam,

Thank you for your question posed regarding increased rates of employer retention relative to student loan repayment in the HB 28 hearing that occurred on February 17th. Please find attached a copy of the Millennial Benefit Preferences study conducted by FC Consulting. The retention question is outlined on page 6 of the study.

The study was administered to 717 business professionals. Respondents were asked "(i)f an employer provided you with competitive salary, benefits, and perks, about how long would you expect to stay with this employer?" On average, respondents said they would stay at least 3.7 years at a company. When asked the same question but with student loan repayment as an added benefit, respondents on average said they would stay 5 years at a company. This translates into a 36% or 1.3 year increase of retention for employers offering student loan repayment vs those that do not.
