I just wanted to drop a line and say thanks so much for introducing SB 176.

I am a lifelong Alaskan but am going to school in Southern California. The weather is beautiful, but the laws are terrible down here. However, I am often on the UAA campus in the summer and when I visit friends at home, and unholstering and leaving my gun in the car has always been a pain. I am in full support of campus carry.

I would like to see two more gun rights bills:

1. Eliminate the provision that mandates concealed carry 21+ instead of 18+ years old. I am 20 and end up open carrying a lot of the time, or just breaking the law and conceal carrying anyway. I turn 21 soon, but why should our rights start at 21?
2. Eliminate the provision that breaks my 5th amendment rights by requiring me to inform an officer that I am carrying.
