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FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation directs the department to develop a model policy relating to cell phone use in schools during school hours, that include lunch and passing periods. The restriction applies to personal wireless devices with a possible exception for emergency use.			
During the October 8-9, 2024, State Board of Education Meeting, the board passed a <u>resolution</u> (item 12 on the agenda) regarding cell phone use in schools during the school day. The department was directed to create a model policy restricting the use of personal devices during the school day. The draft model policy was presented to the board during the January 22, 2025, meeting.			
While there are costs associated with the development of regulations, these costs can be absorbed at this time. Should these costs increase beyond the departments budgeted authority, funding may be requested at a future date.			
This bill takes effect July 1, 2025 (FY2026).			

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
