For fiscal year (FY) 2024, 2,281 students were awarded the APS for a total of \$7,823.0. Due to changes enacted in HB 148, APS eligibility increased to 3,200. At this time, actual usage is unknown. However, coupled with the increase in award amounts, there may be a need for an increment to cover increased scholarship disbursements for FY2026 forward. The total appropriation requested does not exceed the maximum funding amount allowed in statute for the APS and Alaska Education Grants.

The Alaska Education Grants (AEG) will increase as a result of the projected Alaska Performance Scholarship (APS) increase. Annually, the Department of Revenue determines the amount available from the Higher Education Investment Fund for appropriation for the APS and AEG. Of that amount, two-thirds is available for the APS and one-third for the AEG. Therefore, if the APS amount awarded increases, a corresponding one-third of that amount needs to be appropriated for AEG recipients. The total appropriation requested does not exceed the maximum funding amount allowed in statute for the APS and AEG.
