## **Sectional Analysis**

## Senate Bill 81

- Section 1: Requires employers participating in the Teachers' Retirement System to annually contribute a rate, as determined by the Alaska Retirement Management Board, sufficient to pay for normal costs of the plan and for liquidating any past service liability.
- Section 2: Requires employers participating in the Public Employees' Retirement System to annually contribute a rate, as determined by the Alaska Retirement Management Board, sufficient to pay for normal costs of the plan and for liquidating any past service liability.

Section 3: Establishes an immediate effective date.
