Analysis

SB 13 would require the Department of Family and Community Services to do all things necessary to qualify for the "summer electronic benefits transfer program" as authorized under 42 U.S.C. 1762. The Department of Family and Community Services, historically, has not administered EBT programs deccribed by this bill.

Due to the unknown requirements and needs to support this requirement within the Department, the fiscal impacts are unknown.
