STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB110

Analysis

This bill amends AS 14.57, *Museums and Natural and Cultural History Repositories*, to establish a matching grant program for museum construction and expansion with the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development, Division of Community and Regional Affairs (DCRA). The bill would also establish maximum grant project costs and matching funds requirements. DCRA will be responsible for administering the new grant program.

The division anticipates using existing personnel to develop, implement, and administer the new grant program and so fiscal impact is not anticipated at this time. The capitalization of the program is not yet known and is shown as indeterminate in this fiscal note. If the capitalization resulted in more than 25 annual grants, additional staff support may be required.
