


ALASKA STATEWIDE SOCIAL CHALLENGES

- Alaska faces several health challenges including high rates of:
 - Cancer
 - Heart disease
 - High blood pressure
 - High cholesterol
 - Drug overdose (up 44.5% from 2022 to 2023, now 2nd in the nation)
 - Alcohol poisoning (1st in the nation for 2024)
 - Suicide (3rd in the nation for 2022)

CHALLENGES OF SERVING INCARCERATED POPULATION

- Concentration of high physical health care needs, substance use disorder, and mental illness
 - 65% living with a mental illness
 - 80% have a substance use disorder
 - Twice as likely to have high blood pressure and related chronic disease
 - More than twice as likely to use tobacco
- Aging Population
 - Age 50+ 2003 10.8%
 - Age 50+ 2023 21.4%

Mortality rate per 100,000 state prisoners, by cause of death, 2001–2019






DEATHS WHILE IN CUSTODY 2015-2024

Manner of Death




Natural Causes Breakdown






IN-CUSTODY DEATHS DEMOGRAPHICS 2015-2024


In-Custody Deaths by Race
