ADD: It is the intent of the legislature that, with regards to the Air Quality situation in the Fairbanks North Star Borough, the Department of Environmental Conservation shall:

1. Submit a Serious State Implementation Plan (SIP) as quickly as possible that includes sufficiently stringent Best Available Control Technologies (BACT) and Best Available Control Measures (BACM) to be legally defensible and approvable by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
2. Maintain adequate DEC staff in the Fairbanks North Star Borough and streamline the Notice of Violation (NOV) process to ensure compliance with current regulations in place and additional regulations implemented under the Serious SIP.
3. DEC shall coordinate with local governments impacted by PM 2.5 non-attainment to best utilize municipal powers for mitigation, monitoring and enforcement to the maximum extend possible under state and local law.

EXPLANATION: Besides the negative health effects of prolonged exposure to high PM 2.5 levels, the added consequences of not having an EPA approved Serious SIP will eventually result in federal sanctions which would have significant negative economic impacts on the State of Alaska and the Fairbanks North Star Borough, specifically, impoundment of federal highway funds in excess of \$37 million per year.
