Analysis

This bill is an act that is related to education funding, the public education fund, and base student allocation. This bill shifts the state aid from AS 14.17.400 <i>State aid for districts</i> to AS 14.17.410 <i>Public school funding</i> which consists of state aid, a required local contribution, and eligible federal impact aid. The bill removes the base student allocation, making public school funding basic need equal to the amount appropriated by the legislature for state aid, distributed proportionately to a district according to their district adjusted average daily membership (ADM). State funding for state boarding schools is amended to be a direct appropriation, except funding for intensive services.
The public education fund is repealed. All appropriated public school funding will be administered from the general fund within the Foundation Program component.
The fiscal impact of this legislation on the Foundation Program component cannot be determined because of the lack of statute under which to calculate an appropriation.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2025 (FY2026).
