Analysis

This bill is an act that is related to education funding, the public education fund, and base student allocation. This bill shifts the state aid from AS 14.17.400 *State aid for districts* to AS 14.17.410 *Public school funding* which consists of state aid, a required local contribution, and eligible federal impact aid. The bill removes the base student allocation, making public school funding basic need to equal the amount appropriated by the legislature for state aid, distributed proportionately to a district according to their district adjusted average daily membership (ADM). State funding for state boarding schools is amended to be a direct appropriation, except funding for intensive services.

The public education fund is repealed. All appropriated public school funding will be administered from the general fund within the Foundation Program component. All appropriated student transportation funding will be administered from the general fund within the Pupil Transportation component.

This legislation eliminates the public education fund, thereby removing the need for any future appropriations to it. As a result, the fiscal note reflects \$0 for FY2026 through FY2031

This bill takes effect July 1, 2025 (FY2026).
