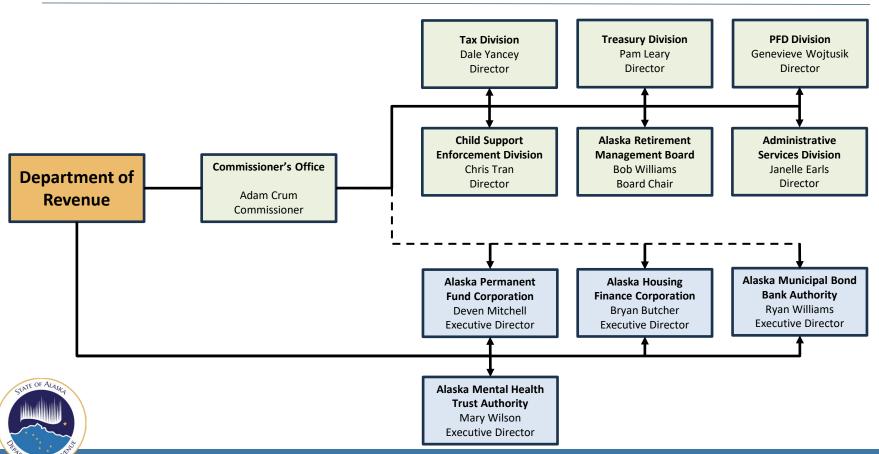

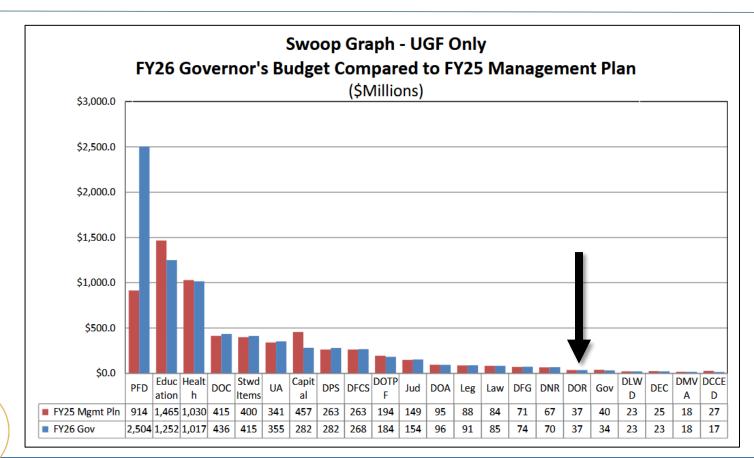

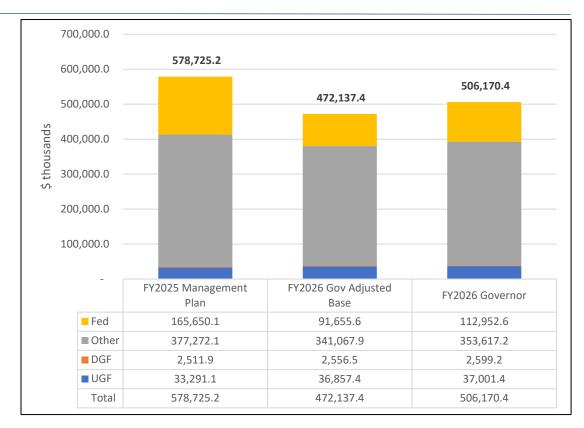
Department Overview: Statewide UGF Comparison

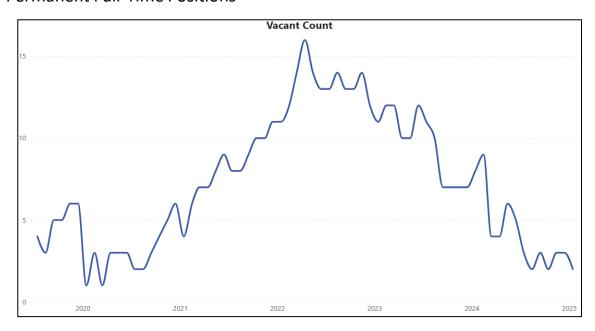

FY2025 Update

The Division of Personnel implemented a Class Study for 107 Child Support Enforcement Specialist positions in December 2023

- Resulted in two range increases
- Required a \$1,275.4 increment in FY2025 (\$452.9 UGF; \$822.5 Fed)

Vacancy and Turnover Outcomes

- ✓ Vacancies have decreased from 26 to nine as of January 2025 data; 24 percent to eight percent
- ✓ Average resignations have decreased from 1.6 per month in the 12 months prior to 0.33 in the 12 months after implementation

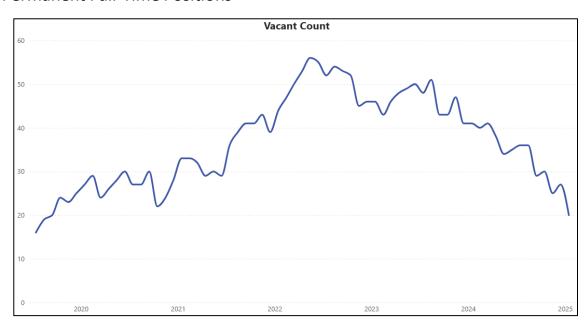

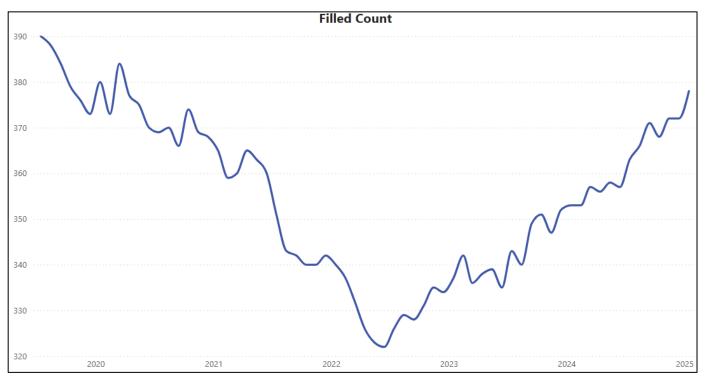
