Please Pass SB54, extending the AELS Board and providing registration for interior designers.

This bill establishes requirements for the practice of registered interior design, providing qualified interior designers the opportunity to take responsibility for their scope of work with independent stamp and seal privileges.

SB54 will ensure that Federal Government projects requiring registration for all design disciplines can include **Alaska-registered interior designers**, rather than hiring interior designers registered out-of-state.

This bill allows Alaska interior designers to practice as they currently are, or to become registered with stamp and seal privileges. It will attract and retain young professionals seeking Alaska registration, keep federal project design revenue and registration fees in Alaska; and increase workforce development opportunities.
