FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

•
This legislation adds AS 44.28.020 requiring the Department of Corrections (DOC) to report each incident of use of force by a correctional, probation or parole officer to the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI).
DOC currently collects and reviews all use of force incidents that occur and report to either the Alaska State Troopers or the Alaska Police Standards Council based on the circumstances (criminal, disciplinary, litigation, etc) as outlined in the DOC internal policy requirements. Adding the additional reporting of any incidents to the FBI will not have a substantial impact on operations; therefore, there is no anticipated fiscal impact with this legislation.
This legislation also requires the department to adopt regulations by January 1, 2024 necessary to implement the required reporting under this new section AS 44.28.020.
