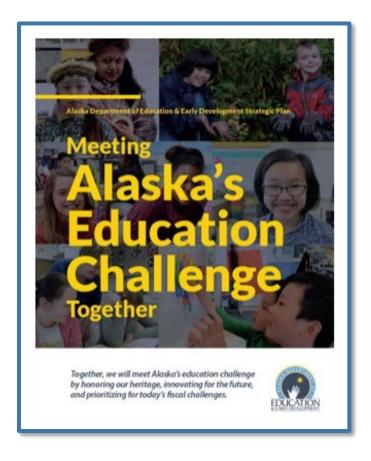
AS 14.07.020. Duties of the department.

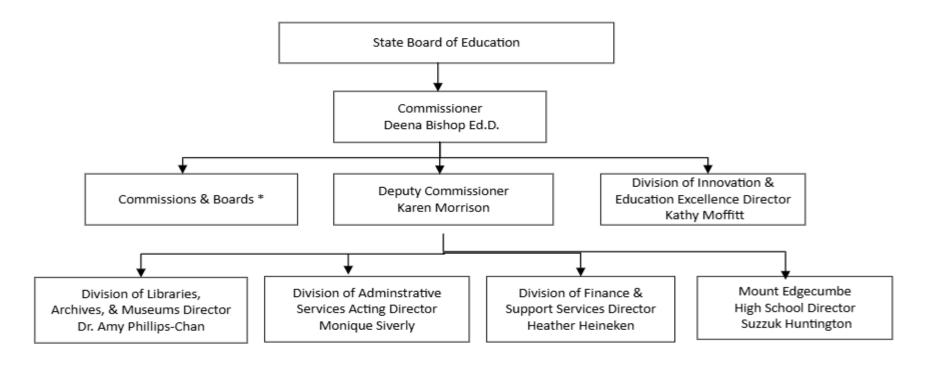

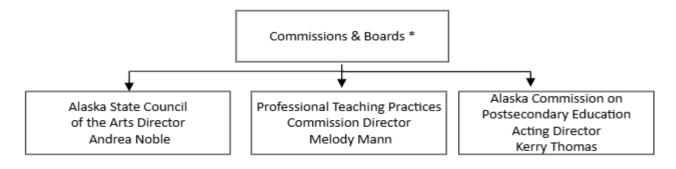

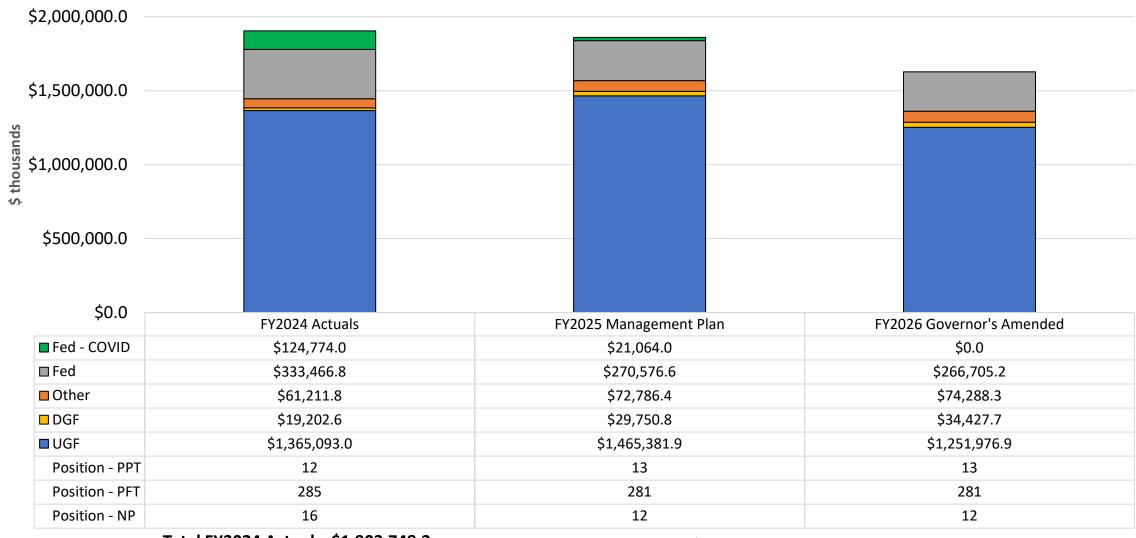

DEED Operating Budget and Position History (FY2024-FY2026)



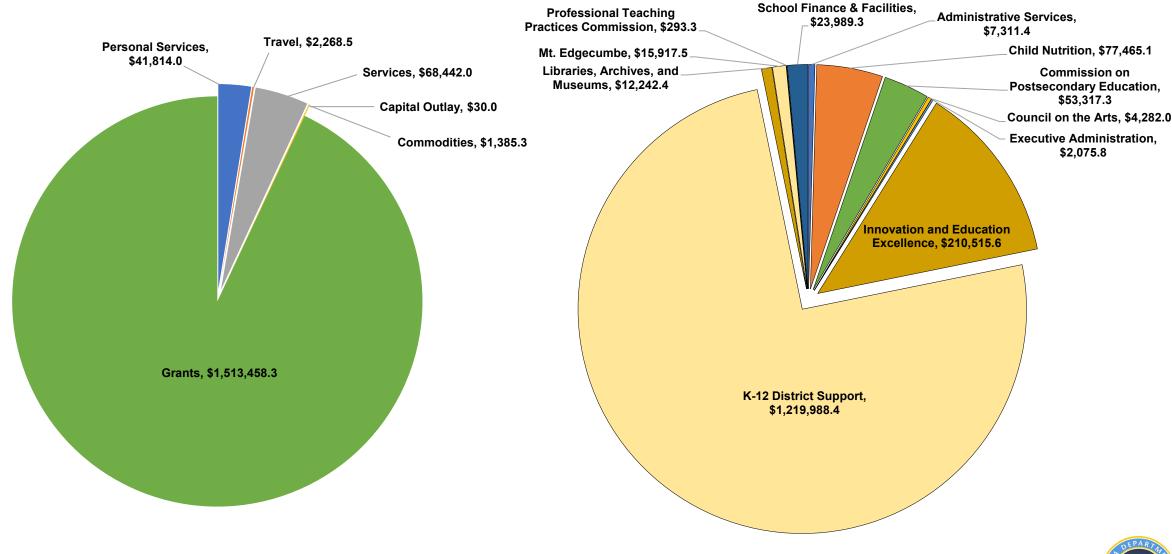

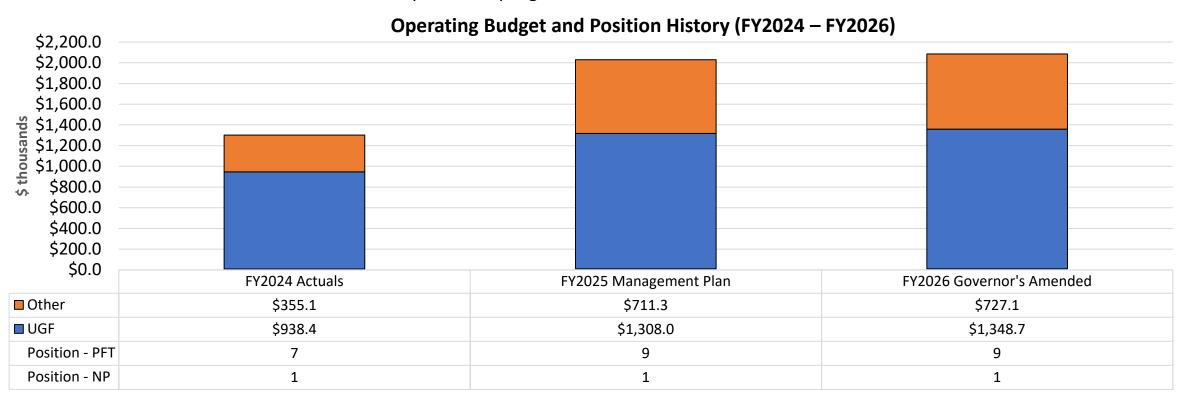
DEED FY2026 Governor's Amended Budget (\$ thousands)

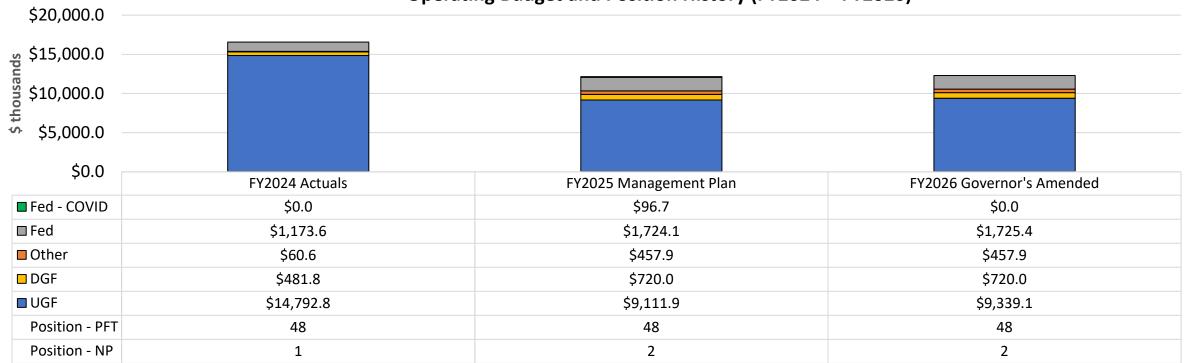

Alaska Performance Scholarship

- Preliminary Alaska Performance Scholarship (APS) Outcomes
 - 45 percent = APS eligibility for the Class of 2024 (compared to 17 percent 2022 and 2023)
 - 3,745 = Largest number of APS eligible graduates
 - \$13 Million = Greatest amount of APS awarded in FY2025 (compared to less than seven million dollars in FY2024)
 - Nearly two times higher = Increase in the number of students using the APS

Ongoing APS Efforts

- The Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education leads the Alaska Performance Scholarship Cross Agency Work Group to inform, enhance, and collaborate on Alaska Performance Scholarship implementation, communication, and more
- Continue to build and expand Alaska Performance Scholarship campaigns to maximize statewide reach



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
