Good Morning,

I am writing as the current assistant principal of Mountain View Elementary in Kenai Alaska. Next year, I will be the principal of this school. **Please take action and permanently increase the BSA.**

It is hiring season. I am desperately attempting to retain and recruit teachers and other staff members for my school. Mountain View Elementary is a wonderful place. We are a Title I school and we have the largest special education program in the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District. We have excellent staff retention, with the majority of our teachers having worked here for 10+ years.

All of that being said, teachers and school staff are tired. COVID-19 was hard on educators across the state and country. Staff are still recovering. They are working with significant student learning loss, both academically and socially. My 5th grade teachers are working to teach 27+ students in all subject areas with student ability levels ranging from beginning Kindergarten to late middle school. They are doing this alone, with very little academic support in our classrooms. Our interventionists are swamped attempting to assist all of these students, and are only serving the students functioning far below average. While working to meet students where they are at academically, teachers and staff around the state are dealing with decreased attendance, increased behavior issues, and increased parent apathy.

Teachers and school staff members are miracle workers, yes, but they can't work miracles with insufficient resources. Teachers are leaving our state, and new ones aren't coming to replace them. School districts need money to fund school staff fully and provide financial incentives for people to want to work in our state. I am faced with class sizes of approximately 30 students in each of my third, fourth, and fifth grade classes next year due to staffing cuts.

From a school employee perspective, it seems that there is a war waging against public education. Nasty rumors are spread daily about what is happening inside public school walls. I hear words like "indoctrination", "woke teachers", etc. There is no hidden agenda in the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District. We are working diligently to help kids learn both academically and socially. We are teaching and shaping our country's future. Increasing the BSA is not "throwing money at a problem", it is giving highly trained, highly qualified educators the incentive and support they need to teach effectively in Alaska.

Please help us do this by permanently allocating the funding we need to prosper.

Dear members of the House Finance Committee and Senator Kaufman,

Good morning to you all. Last week, SB 52 passed the Senate and was referred to your committee. **I want to briefly and respectfully urge you to hear SB52 and move it out of committee as soon as today.**

SB 52, like HB 65, would codify a \$680/student increase to the Base Student Allocation. But SB 52 also contains an additional 11% increase to Pupil Transportation.

As a member of the Anchorage School Board, I am confident that the BSA increase would amount to **~\$49 million for ASD in FY24** and that the Pupil Transportation increase would bring an **additional \$2.5 million to the district next year**. These formulaic changes would give ASD a **historic funding boost** that would allow the district to **focus on student outcomes during FY24 and prepare a balanced budget for FY25**.

As I've shared before, ASD has already prepared and approved a balanced budget for FY24, based on \$65 million in one-time funds and a +1 increase in pupil to teacher ratios across the K-12 system, but is projecting a **\$85 million deficit for FY25**. The passage of SB 52 would enable ASD to retain most of the \$49 million from FY24 and apply those funds to those received for FY 25. Given that ASD will prepare and approve the FY25 budget in February 2024, the timeliness of SB52 is of the essence!

I am grateful that when my own Senator, James Kaufman, supported the final passage SB 52, he asserted that "we have to provide funding. You can't improve a process if it's in a critical state of failure." I urge each of you to do the same in this committee and thereby allow your colleagues the opportunity to improve public education across the State of Alaska.

Thank you for your service and dedication, and best wishes for the end of this legislative session.

Dear Legislators,

Thank you for all of your hard work during this legislative season with the monumental task of creating a budget that best serves all of the state of Alaska. This email is to give you my insight as a constituent of what I feel priorities for our state need to be. My first request is that you don't "kick the can down the road" which to so many Alaskans feel has been happening for too many years. We need a steady source of revenue to build our infrastructure and get our state back on track as the robust state we can be. As we have learned from our continuous outmigration over the last 10 years, our financial forecast is sinking Alaska if we continue on the path we have been. Inadequate state support for K-12 schools and the university system, lack of available housing, a shortage of child care and better economic opportunities elsewhere have been cited for our weak economy. Therefore, we need to provide the resources to correct this.

Most important for your consideration is to pass SB52, the Base Student Allowance to support our kids and give them the resources they need. Our school districts are struggling under the weight of inflation and a nationwide labor shortage which has made it increasingly difficult to hire teachers and school support staff. Therefore, we also need to bring back the defined benefit/pension program for state employees including teachers, peace offices, and firefighters. Along with this would be HB46 & 89 helping parents with child care legislation. These are some of the measures that will increase the financial security and an easing of mental health of our state.

I agree that it's ok to receive a full dividend if we generate the resources to pay for it. I don't agree with those who feel you don't want to tax people to pay for a dividend. This is because the dividend provides different levels of support depending on your financial status, ie, the less income you have, the more meaningful and impact the dividend will have on your overall needs. This is the reason I am not a fan of a sales tax. It is shown to be regressive, hurting lower income and rural areas more than others. I am, however, in favor of an income tax (HB56) because this is a much more equitable tax allowing lower income people to be taxed less and also captures people from out of state who come here, use our resources and then leave our state to spend their money elsewhere, but pay Alaska next to nothing for our support of their earnings. An Income Tax would provide stability to the revenue stream in the face of volatility in the price of oil.

I am also in favor of SB114 which allows for greater fairness to Alaska for what we receive for our oil. This would apply the state corporate income tax to all the major producers regardless of the corporate form they choose to use when operating in Alaska and reduce the per barrel credits from \$8 per barrel to \$5 per barrel and link them to actual investment which is a huge improvement to support greater resources for Alaska and would take effect immediately. It is true that the oil industry has provided great resources to Alaska, but it is just as true that Alaska has not negotiated very well over the years to get the best resources for our state. As a state, we get the lowest return on investment than any of the other oil states. The oil companies will argue that it's because of where we are and the added expenses, etc, but this is factored in already and last year the oil companies made record profits. Plus, when SB21 got passed, they made promises they didn't keep, but keep telling us with any possible increase we consider that now is not a good time to make these changes and threaten us with the possibility of losing jobs, etc (while they make record profits). We already are and already have lost many jobs and we need changes to move forward at a pivotal time for our financial survival.

None of these efforts alone will solve the financial woes we now have, but if we enact the above items, I feel it will fill many of the gaps that we now experience and not have to consider drawing from the CBR which will reduce our overall ability to earn money in the long run. Please be brave and break the cycle of pushing the can down the road. Don't let

the oil companies bully you and make a stand to do what is right for ALL Alaskans. Even if you've taken a stance on something in the past like "no taxes" it's ok to change your stand when helping Alaskans to prosper in these difficult times if you explain your rationale and help our state develop a steady resource for the infrastructure we need.


