## House Bill 28 – Access to Marijuana Conviction Records

### *Explanation of Changes version S to U*

1. In Section 3 (AS 12.62.160 (f)(5)), page 3, lines 5-6
  - a. Deletes subsection (5) “pays a fee established by the agency in regulation in an amount that is not less than \$150”

This change removes an amendment previously adopted by the House Judiciary Committee which would require a fee be paid by the individual in addition to requesting their low-level marijuana conviction records not be released.
