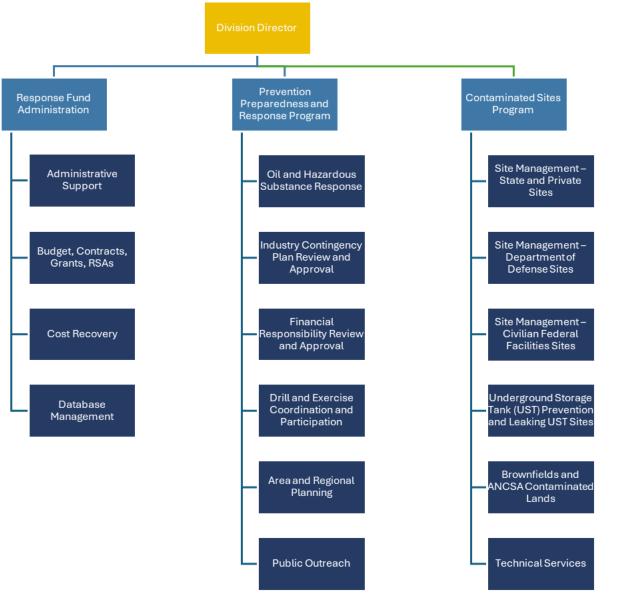


### **SPAR's Mission**

### **Spill Prevention and Response Organization**





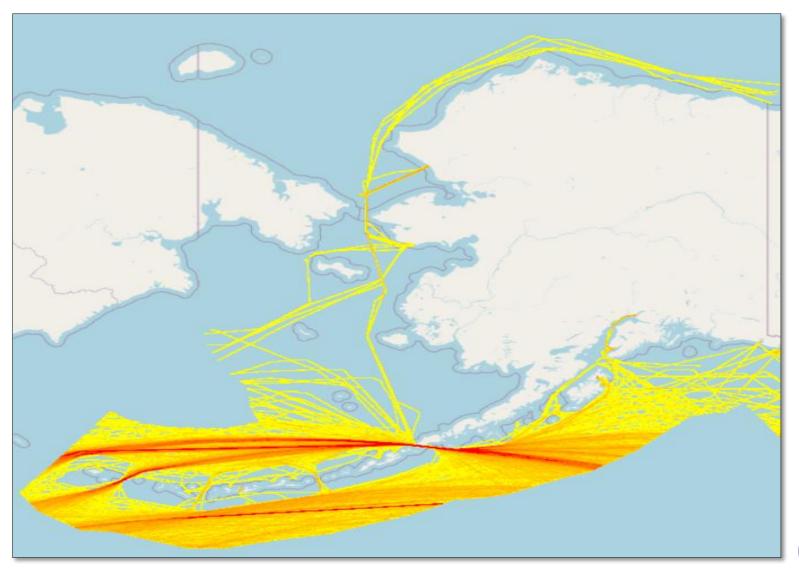
### **Prevention Preparedness and Response**



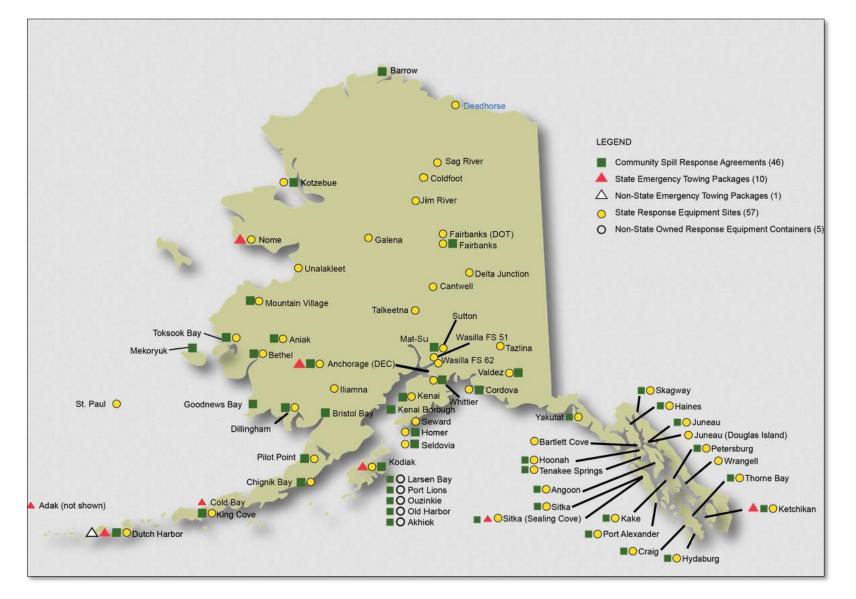

Protect human health and the environment by identifying, overseeing, and conducting timely, science based, and defensible characterization, clean up, redevelopment, and management of contaminated sites







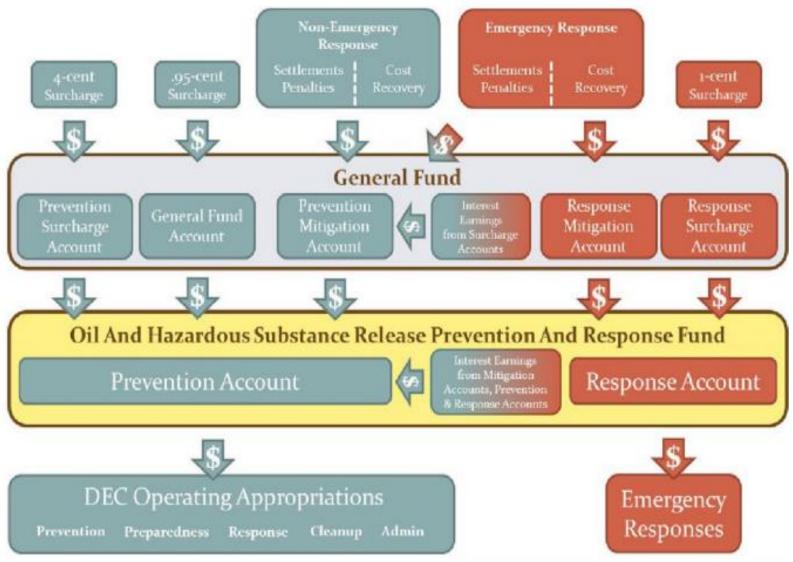


### **Response Fund Administration**

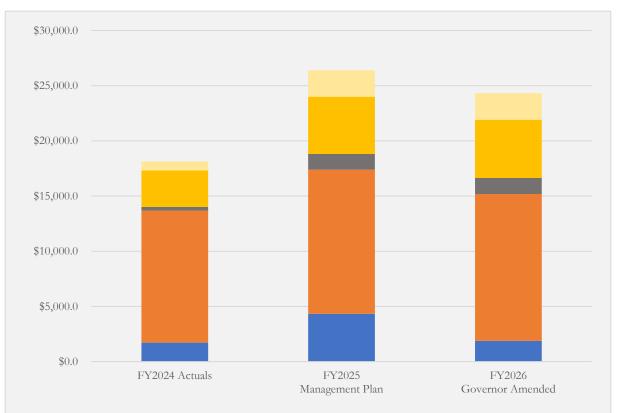


#### **RESPONSE FUND FLOW CHART**
