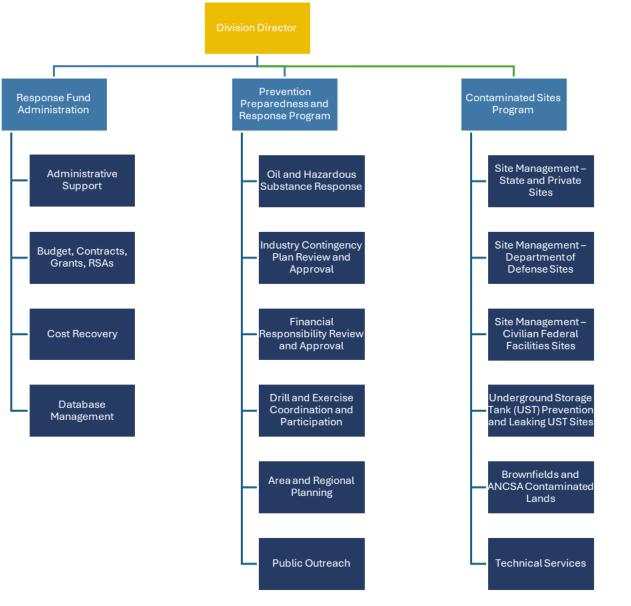


SPAR's Mission

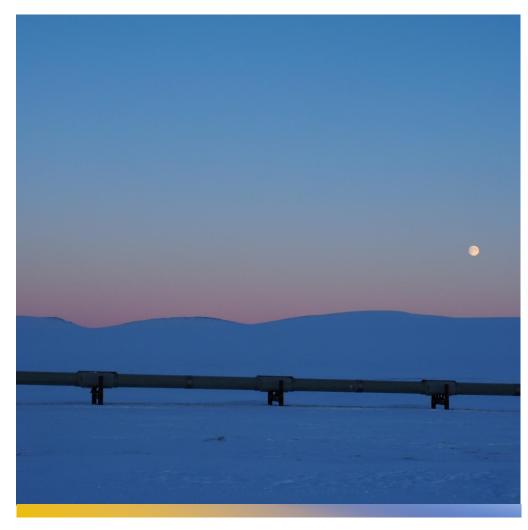


Spill Prevention and Response Organization





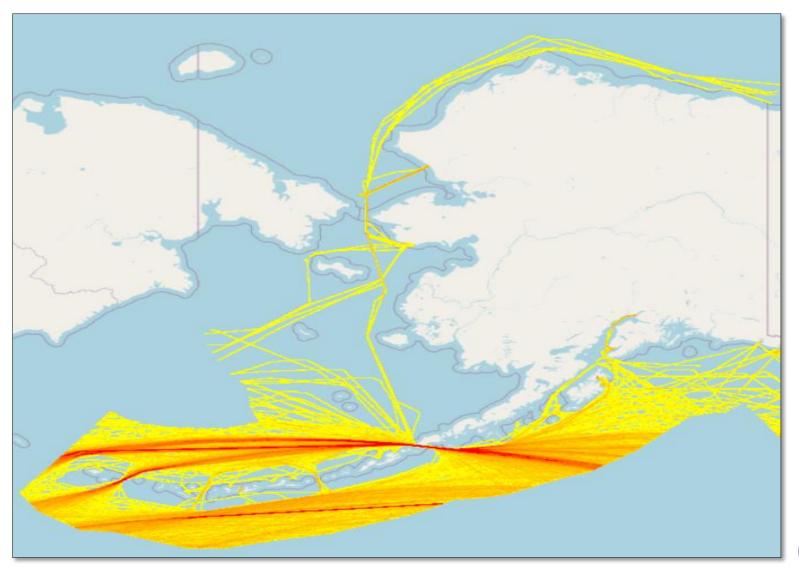
Prevention Preparedness and Response



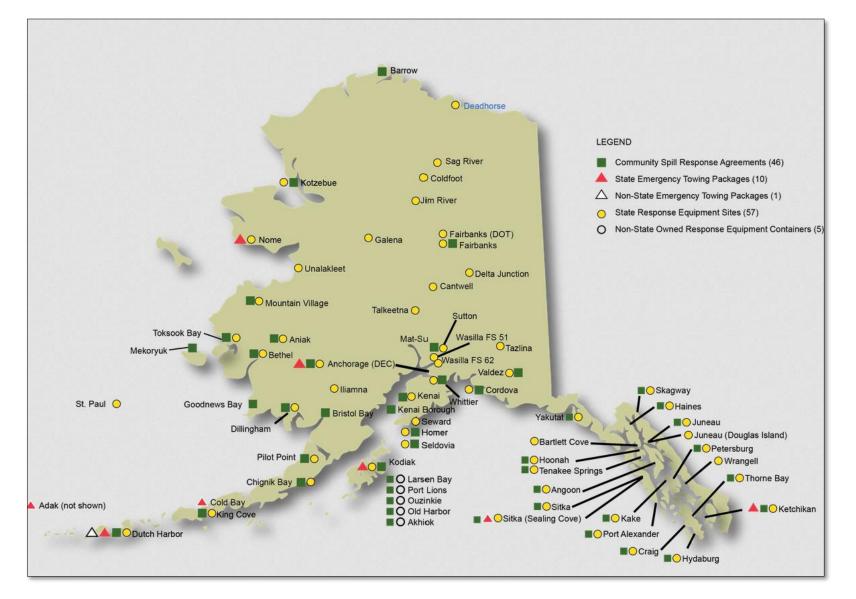

North Pacific Great Circle Route







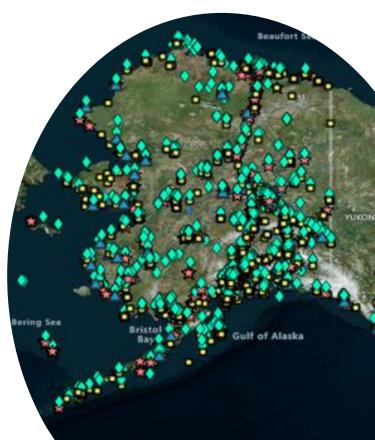
Pre-Staged Response Equipment & Towing Systems

Protect human health and the environment by identifying, overseeing, and conducting timely, science based, and defensible characterization, clean up, redevelopment, and management of contaminated sites







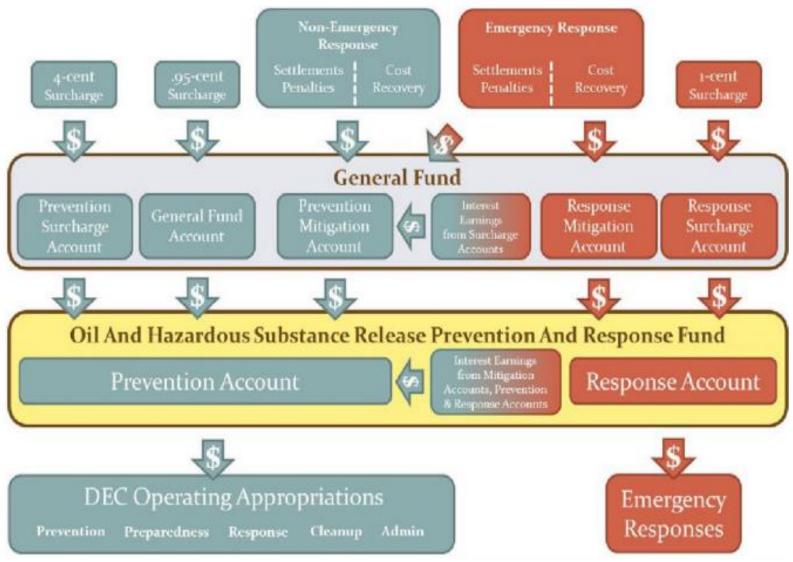


Response Fund Administration

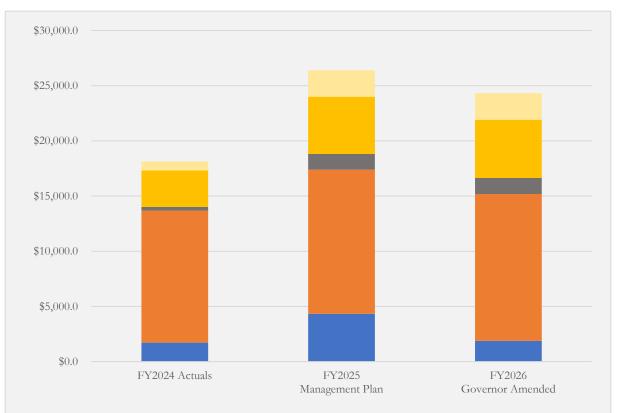


RESPONSE FUND FLOW CHART
