Section 2

New subsection added that "Not later than January 15 of each year, a district shall provide to each student in the district who is enrolled in grade nine or grade 10 information about the Alaska performance scholarship (APS)". This subsection ensures that students receive information about the APS program earlier in their high school career and may positively influence their decision to attend an Alaska postsecondary institution.

Section 4

Changes in this section are added consistent with the technical changes in Section 7. Language "or the equivalent established under (g) of this section" now added to (1), (2), and (3) in section 4.

Section 7

(g) adds language to ensure high schools who do not award grades on a four-point scale, or five-point scale for advanced placement classes will be able to participate in the APS award program.
