	WHEREAS, Alaska is endowed with abundant natural gas reserves on the North Slope, offering a significant opportunity to enhance energy security and economic development for the state; and				
	WHEREAS, The completion of a natural gas pipeline from the North Slope is critical for delivering affordable and reliable energy to Fairbanks and the Interior, reducing dependence on costly fuel oil and other energy sources; and				
	WHEREAS, Access to natural gas aligns with the Fairbanks North Star Borough's goals of improving air quality, reducing greenhouse gas emissions, and transitioning to cleaner and more sustainable energy sources; and				
	WHEREAS, The development of such a pipeline would stimulate economic growth through job creation, lower energy costs, and increased business opportunities for local residents and businesses; and				
	WHEREAS, The Alaska Gasline Development Corporation has advanced plans for the Alaska LNG project, a major infrastructure initiative that would connect North Slope natural gas to markets throughout the state and beyond; and				

WHEREAS, Natural gas access is integral to achieving Fairbanks' Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy objectives of lowering energy costs and fostering a resilient and diversified energy portfolio; and

WHEREAS, The availability of affordable natural gas would support air quality improvements through expanded oil-to-gas conversion programs, which have been successful in reducing particulate matter pollution in the region.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the Fairbanks North Star Borough fully supports the development, completion, and operation of a natural gas pipeline from the North Slope, with a structurally and financially integrated Fairbanks' connector, ensuring access to affordable natural gas for Fairbanks and the Interior.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Assembly encourages the State of Alaska and relevant stakeholders to prioritize pipeline construction and ensure a cost-effective and sustainable supply of natural gas for Interior Alaska.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Assembly authorizes the Mayor to advocate for and participate in discussions, agreements, and initiatives that support this project and benefit the Borough's residents.
