Children's Advocacy Centers

Granting Authority: 7AAC 78 - Grant Programs

Description of Services: Children's Advocacy Centers (CACs) help to identify maltreated children and protect them from further harm. CAC's provide referrals

to treatment and follow up, hold offenders accountable, and provide community outreach and education regarding child abuse. A comprehensive, child-centered response in suspected cases of child abuse includes the coordinated efforts of a multidisciplinary team including law enforcement, district attorneys and the assistant attorney general's office, child protection, victim advocates, as well as

mental and medical health professionals.

Assessment of Need: Centers accept referrals of suspected sexual abuse and other severe abuse of children up to age 18. Most also accept referrals of

developmentally disabled young adults and those with cognitive impairments such as Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder.

Referrals continue to increase due to the State's broad support for effective CACs and increased community awareness regarding child abuse and child sexual abuse. Current centers are stable but not self-sustaining. This will also offer some cost savings to CACs currently

serving children from outside the center's locale.
