## **SB 171 Residency Req: Hunting, Trapping, Fishing Ver. A Sectional Analysis**

**Section 1** – Adds language to AS 16.05.400 establishing that a person with a permanent identification card must continue to meet residency requirements.

**Section 2** – Adds to the residency requirement in AS 16.05.415(a) that the person must be physically present in the state for the 12 months immediately prior to applying for a resident license unless absent for as allowed under the Permanent Fund Dividend statutes.

**Section 3** – Adds to the residency requirement in AS 16.05.415(e) that the person must be physically present in the state for the prior 12 months to the application for a resident license unless absent as allowed under the Permanent Fund Dividend statutes.

**Section 4** – Adds a new section (j) to AS 16.05.415 requiring the Department of Fish and Game Commissioner to adopt regulations for determining eligibility for an Alaska resident hunting, trapping, or fishing license and allowing for the use of information from other state agencies in determining eligibility.

**Section 5** – Transitional language allowing the Department to adopt regulations.

**Section 6** – Provides an immediate effective date for Section 5.

**Section 7** – Provides an effective date of January 1, 2025 for Sections 1 – 4.
