8 proprietor applies for the license or will reach 65 years of age at any  
9 time during the year for which the license is issued; or

10 (ii) [(2)] a disabled veteran; and

11 (2) the fee is waived for the first year the initial business license is  
12 issued if the person holding the business license has not previously been issued a  
13 business license."

7           (c) Except as provided in (f) - (l) [(f) - (k)] of this section, the department shall  
8 establish fee levels under (a) of this section so that the total amount of fees collected  
9 for an occupation approximately equals the actual regulatory costs for the occupation.  
10 The department shall annually review each fee level to determine whether the  
11 regulatory costs of each occupation are approximately equal to fee collections related  
12 to that occupation. If the review indicates that an occupation's fee collections and  
13 regulatory costs are not approximately equal, the department shall calculate fee  
14 adjustments and adopt regulations under (a) of this section to implement the  
15 adjustments. In January of each year, the department shall report on all fee levels and  
16 revisions for the previous year under this subsection to the office of management and  
17 budget. If a board regulates an occupation covered by this chapter, the department  
18 shall consider the board's recommendations concerning the occupation's fee levels and  
19 regulatory costs before revising fee schedules to comply with this subsection. In this  
20 subsection, "regulatory costs" means costs of the department that are attributable to  
21 regulation of an occupation plus

22           (l) all expenses of the board that regulates the occupation if the board  
23 regulates only one occupation;

(2) the expenses of a board that are attributable to the occupation if the board regulates more than one occupation.
