FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This bill will make broad changes within the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) statutes (AS 03.13) and Title 29 (AS 29.71) to promote and finance the production and harvesting of Alaska agricultural and fisheries products by suspending current statutory product preferences. Municipalities, the State, and school districts would be required to purchase agricultural or fisheries products harvested or processed in the state that are comparable in quality to products available out-of-state, regardless of price.

The Division of Community and Regional Affairs does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
