A RESOLUTION

1 **Disapproving Executive Order No. 128.**

2 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 **WHEREAS** the governor, under authority of art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State
4 of Alaska, has proposed in Executive Order No. 128 to separate the membership of the board
5 of directors of the Alaska Energy Authority from the membership of the board of directors of
6 the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority; and

7 **WHEREAS** art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that unless
8 disapproved within 60 days of a regular session by resolution concurred in by a majority of
9 the members of the legislature in joint session, an executive order becomes effective at a date
10 designated by the governor;

11 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Alaska State Legislature that Executive Order No. 128 is
12 disapproved.
