Analysis

SCR 10 creates a seven-member legislative task force on the seafood industry comprised of legislators, industry, and executive branch appointees. The legislation states that all meetings will have a telephonic and/or virtual participation option and it is the sponsor's intent that members who choose to travel for task force meetings use existing funds. Additionally, any necessary task force materials and staff support will be provided from existing resources. As such, this fiscal note assumes no new funds are necessary to support the work of this task force.
