## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB 158

### Analysis

This bill changes the date a school district applies for a major maintenance or school construction grant from September 1 to July 1.

The bill amends various statutes to limit the Department of Education and Early Development and Bond Reimbursement and Grant Review (BRGR) Committee to recommending; for approval, approval, or allocation of a bond debt reimbursement application for either one school construction project or up to two major maintenance projects, except more than two major maintenance projects could be approved if within the top 20 priority grant rankings. It requires that all potential debt reimbursement projects first be considered and applied for as a grant project.

The effective date for this legislation is July 1, 2025 (FY2026).

The fiscal impact of this legislation cannot be determined because of the uncertainty of how many debt reimbursement applications will be received after July 1, 2025, and the total requested project principal and bond costs. State repayment of school bond debt reimbursement projects that are voter-approved after July 1, 2025 will be requested starting in FY2026.
