FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. CSSB 44(HSS)

Analysis

SB 44 revises the licensing requirements and scope of practice for naturopaths, allowing a greater ability to practice if the licensee has attained relevant education and training and establishes a naturopathy advisory board.

If this bill passes, the division will require one long term non-permanent (LTNP) Administrative Assistant 1 for six months to handle fingerprint cards, and two short term nonpermanent (STNP) Occupational Licensing Examiners (OLE) for four months to re-examine all existing licensee credentials.

If the bill passes, the following expenses will be incurred in FY2025 only:

Personal Services: \$102.2 One (1) LTNP Administrative Assistant 1 (R12) and two (2) LTNP Occupational Licensing Examiners (R14)

Services: \$75.0 Core services charges (\$25.0/position)
\$2.5 Legal costs to amend regulations, printing, and postage

Commodities: \$30.0 One-time set up costs (\$10.0/position)

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services – fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065. The total amount of revenue collected approximately equals each occupation's actual regulatory costs.
