Ms. Rittgers,

Currently if someone uses a disabled veterans pass, day use parking pass, or boat launch pass fraudulently, it would be treated as if the person had no pass at all, and the Rangers would proceed under 11AAC 12.250(a) Fee enforcement that has a bail of \$50 with a \$20 court surcharge.

With the State Parks DAV, parking and boat launch passes, there is currently no mechanism for us to seize the pass if it is being used fraudulently, as there is with commercial permits.
