BILL NO. HB 391

Analysis

House Bill 391 allows the State Board of Education to authorize a charter school. The bill also directs the board to create a series of regulations that support a charter school when the state contracts with the district to provide oversight to the state board-authorized charter school.

The implementation of this Act takes effect July 1, 2024.

There is no fiscal impact to the department for this bill.
