Dear Aniak Light & Power Customers,

We are sympathetic of your distress over our abnormally-high fuel surcharge, and are sorry for the anxiety it has caused. We are pursuing a surcharge adjustment that spreads last year's exorbitant fuel cost over a longer period (twelve months instead of three). We are also hoping for a retroactive adjustment. Until we get regulatory approval for an adjustment, we can only use the approved surcharge. If an adjustment is not approved in a timely manner, the surcharge will be at least as high another month, and then gradually decrease, projected to be less than \$1/KWH before next year. A gradual decrease is expected, with or without an approved change to the surcharge formula.

This month's bill has the abnormally-high surcharge again. We understand that many customers cannot pay their bill in full. We urge you to pay an amount representing a "normal" bill. We will work with, and delay disconnects for, those making payments representing their "normal" bills. If no payment was received in the previous month, you are subject to disconnect, as before. We urge all our customers to make payments and take measures to reduce energy usage. If you have a credit balance, please conserve energy to help your credit last longer.

For those who have not paid, and do not pay, we will have to exercise the right to disconnect, and nonpayment should be cause for concern.

We appreciate all of our customers, but are especially grateful for those who have made payments with little or no complaint – all certainly have reason to complain - and those who make special effort to reduce energy usage.
