This bill increases the base student allocation (BSA) in AS 14.17.470 from \$5,960 to \$6,960, equaling \$253,201.2 (thousands) in additional state aid for districts through the Foundation Program as an appropriation to the Public Education Fund.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2025 (FY2026).
The funding mechanism is a general fund transfer to the Public Education Fund (PEF). The fiscal note effect for FY2026 through FY2031 is reported in the fiscal note for the PEF, as the funding is deposited to the PEF, not into the Foundation Program funding component.
