#### STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

#### BILL NO. CSHB101

#### Analysis

This bill amends various crimes relating to minors such as murder, enticement of a minor, sexual abuse of a minor and distribution of indecent material to minors to increase the age of the child victim to 18 years of age. While the bill endeavors to preserve the protections for individuals who are close in age that are found in current law, it broadens the scope of existing crimes. This will likely result in additional case referrals, cases filed, and an increased need for training.

While it is unknown how many additional cases the Criminal Division will see should this bill become law the division submits a zero fiscal note at this time. The Criminal Division will continue to monitor the impacts of this bill and assess whether additional resources may be needed in the future.
