I have practiced veterinary medicine in Alaska since 1972 and I would see this bill diluting and devaluing the veterinary profession. This bill would allow a rotating 5 member board the power to change licensing qualifications at will. I agree with many of the profession that veterinary licensing requirements should remain clearly presented in statute and not subject to manipulation by 4 veterinarians and a lay person (all appointed by the Governor).
