In 2024, the Alaska State Commission for Human Rights (ASCHR) undertook a first-ever statewide survey to find out about Alaskans' experience with discrimination. The comprehensive survey fielded questions covering all of ASCHR jurisdictional areas. This effort was carried out in collaboration with the University of Alaska, Anchorage, Institute of Social and Economic Research (ISER) and with support from the Anchorage Equal Right Commission. This Lunch & Learn will provide an overview of the five jurisdictional areas under the ASCHR, and present preliminary survey results by jurisdictional area.

These include:

- Employment
- Places of Public Accommodation
- Housing
- Financial institutions
- Government funds and services

ASCHR will be reviewing the report and discussing considerations for making this information available to policymakers, employers, researchers and others interested in this work.
