- We do NOT prosecute traffic tickets




Types of Cases

- ➤ Violent Homicide, Robbery, Assault, Kidnapping, Sexual Assault, Sexual Abuse of Minor
- Property Theft, Burglary, Criminal Mischief, Forgery, Fraud
- Drugs Possession and Distribution
- > DUI
- ➤ Miscellaneous Misconduct Involving Weapons, Escape, Perjury, Fish & Game, etc.
- Appeals (state and federal courts)
- Petition to Revoke Probation & Post Conviction Relief





- Conviction Rate Returning



(Determined by the mean)


Felonies 2-3 years

Appeals 3-5 years




Prosecutor Vacancy






Paralegal Vacancy


