Dear Co-Chairs Stedman, Hoffman, and Olson,

Thank you for inviting the Office of Management and Budget to present an overview of the Governor's FY2024 Capital budget to the Senate Finance Committee on January 26, 2023. Responses to questions and requests for follow-up information from the committee hearing are included below.

1. Senator Hoffman asked for a description of the need for additional childcare facilities throughout the State.

Research into this topic from the Department of Labor and Workforce Development is forthcoming. In the meantime, the department has provided in attachments 1 through 3 documentation that sheds some light on the matter.

2. Senator Merrick asked if there would be federal revenue available to assist with the ongoing operations and maintenance costs of the Veterans Cemetery.

The operating cost associated with the Veterans Cemetery would be covered 100% by the State. The only cost the federal government would cover is \$750.00 for each approved burial.
